- * GIS/GPS Mapping

 - * A geo-database compatible with ArcGIS Maps
 - * The database will contain all features collected and digitized as listed in the scope of work
 - Wall & book maps (if desired and ordered)
 - Published digital map for viewing with GeoSync-XG Gold
 - * Standard GIS datasets (road centerlines, aerial imagery, topography maps, etc.)





- * Video Inspection of Sewer Lines
 - *Two options
 - *One Day problem area inspection

- * Video Inspection of Sewer Lines (cont.)
 - * Each wastewater line inspected will have an inspection report which diagrams all of the inspection features.
 - * Each pipeline inspection will be recorded on DVD (and provided to the utility) with filenames tagged to the reports for easy reference.

- * System Management
 - * Nothing good down this road!
 - * Receiverships
 - * IRWA has been named receiver for systems twice



- * Rural Water Loan Fund (RWLF)
 - Available through NRWA (NRWA.org)
 - * Pre-development (planning) costs for infrastructure projects
 - Replacement equipment, system upgrades, maintenance and small capital projects
 - * Energy efficiency projects to lower costs and improve system sustainability
 - Disaster recovery or other emergency loans are available

- * Reasonable interest rate (currently 3%) and a maximum repayment period of 10 years
- Easy application process with a quick turnaround time
- * Loan amounts may not exceed \$100,000 or 75% of the total project cost, whichever is less
- * Emergency loans are 90-day no interest, with immediate turn around on applications
- * NRWA charges no administrative or processing fees
- * Systems must be public entities (municipalities, counties, special purpose districts, Native American Tribes, nonprofit corporations and cooperatives) serving up to 10,000 persons, or in rural areas with no population limits
